



STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR ARCHERY_REVISED_SEP 2021

The following procedures/conditions must be followed:

1. Players shall register at the Archery Range with details (Name, CID No., Vaccination status & place of residence). The Archery Range Operator shall ensure that all players are registered.
2. The Member Secretary to Samtse Archery Association (SAA) shall share and maintain the lists/record of players to the DHO the next day.
3. Players with fever and flu-like symptoms and **UNVACCINATED individuals** shall **not be allowed** to enter the range and participate. SAA and respective team coordinators shall be responsible to ensure the above conditions are fulfilled.
4. All players must undergo thermal scanning at the entry gate. The SAA shall be responsible for providing the thermal scanning facility and ensure its effective implementation.
5. All players must mandatorily use Druk Trace App before entering the archery range.
6. All players shall use face mask during the time of entry and after the match.
7. All players must wash hands before entry and exit from the range. SAA shall ensure adequate hand washing facilities in place at strategic locations.
8. Minimum 1 meter distance must be maintained before match, during the break and after the match.
9. No spectators shall be allowed.
10. The timing for the games shall be from **6:00 AM to 6:00 PM**.
11. The number of players allowed in each team shall be limited to **10 players** only.
12. No tournaments shall be allowed.
13. Online payment of system is recommended for payment of ground fees.
14. SAA shall sanitize and disinfect the public toilet and resting chairs.
15. SDSA and SAA shall take full responsibility and accountability in ensuring the compliance of the above procedures and conditions.
16. Mr. Lhab Tshering and Mr. Kezang Thinley shall ensure compliance and full enforcement of the above SOP and shall serve as focal person to coordinate the matches.

While getting the relaxation to enjoy the Archery, all players and officials must know that there is high risk of community transmission of COVID-19 in the Dzongkhag.

Hence, it is the sole responsibility of the players to strictly observe the health safety protocols and conditions specified in the SOP.
