## NOTIFICATION ON 10 DAYS LOCKDOWN OF TADING GEWOG

This is to notify the general public that one COVID-19 positive has been detected from Amochu Checkpoint on 12.02.2022 during enhanced surveillance and an additional 32 positive cases from Tading Gewog on 13.02.2022. Therefore, based on the epidemiological assessment of COVID-19 presence in the Gewog and upon the recommendation of Technical Advisory Group (TAG) of Ministry of Health, **Tading Gewog shall be under 10 days lockdown with immediate effect until further notice**. The lockdown is being imposed as a containment measure to minimize the spread of the virus in the community, to conduct contact tracing and testing of the people in the Gewog.

The following *measures* shall be implemented during lockdown until further notice:

1. All offices and schools shall remain closed.
2. All shops and businesses shall remain closed.
3. Construction activities and Crushing Units shall be allowed under strict containment mode upon approval by the DC19TF Monitoring and Inspection Team.
4. Farming activities shall be allowed within their premises without mixing with the neighbours.
5. No movement of people and vehicles are allowed, unless authorized for essential purposes.
6. All health related incidents will be attended to and their movement will be facilitated.
7. Aggressive testing and tracing will be carried out during the lockdown to clear the affected community faster.
8. Anyone with flu-like symptoms must inform the Gewog Administration for immediate response.
9. No public gathering shall be allowed (*rituals, marriages, Ceremonies etc.*)
10. No games and sports shall be allowed.

Sorchen	Amochu	4:00 PM
Amochu	Yeezergang	5:30 PM
